ORDER:-

Government of Telangana has taken-up restoration of all Minor Irrigation Tanks in the State to their original capacity and to effectively utilize water allocated for Minor Irrigation sector under Godavari & Krishna River Basins as a flagship programme under the name of “MISSION KAKATIYA”.

2. The Chief Engineer, Minor Irrigation (GB), Hyderabad in his letter first read above has submitted proposal under Mission Kakatiya for “Comprehensive Restoration of (12) Minor Irrigation tanks in Khammam District for according administrative approval.

3. Government after careful examination of the matter, hereby accord administrative approval for an amount of Rs.4,57,43,000/- (Rupees Four Crores Fifty Seven lakhs and Forty Three thousand only) towards “Comprehensive Restoration of (12) Minor Irrigation tanks in Khammam District” for the Financial Year 2017-18 under Mission Kakatiya phase-III Programme, subject to the responsibility of the Chief Engineer, Minor Irrigation (GB), Hyderabad, to follow the following points while giving Technical Sanction and while executing the work. The statement showing the details of tank proposed for restoration is annexed to this order:-

- 1) He must ensure and satisfy from the history of repairs carried out to the tanks that there are no overlap of proposed repairs in any other previous sanctioned schemes, now on-going are taken up recently.
- 2) The cost of repairs must be arrived after thorough investigation and as per the actual requirement of components are quantities for restoration and the provisions made including lump sum provisions are in terms of codal provisions and the guidelines issued in relation thereto.

- 3) The de-siltation provision made in the estimates are based on pre -levels and prudent assessment of quantities involved and in consideration of nature of percolation and potential of the yield.
- 4) Follow due procurement procedures for taking up the works.
4. The expenditure sanctioned in para (3) above shall be debited to the Head of Account "4702 COL on M.I. MH-101-Surface Water GH-11 Normal State Plan SH-(23) – Mission Kakatiya – 530 Major works – 531 Other Expenditure".
5. The Chief Engineer, Minor Irrigation (GB), Hyderabad, shall take necessary action accordingly to complete the work within the stipulated period and submit the utilization certificate to Government. The (12) estimates received through the letter 1st read above are returned herewith.
6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (EBS.IX) Department vide their U.O. No.2193/107/A2/EBS.IX/2017, Dated: 03.03.2017.
